#### TODAY'S READINGS

## Jeremiah 31: 7-9

Thus says the Lord: Sing aloud with gladness for Jacob, and raise shouts for the chief of the nations; proclaim, give praise, and say, 'Save, O Lord, your people, the remnant of Israel.' See, I am going to bring them from the land of the north, and gather them from the farthest parts of the earth, among them the blind and the lame, those with child and those in labour, together; a great company, they shall return here. With weeping they shall come, and with consolations I will lead them back, I will let them walk by brooks of water, in a straight path in which they shall not stumble; for I have become a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn.

#### Mark 10: 46-52

They came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stood still and said, 'Call him here.' And they called the blind man, saying to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is calling you.' So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, 'What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man said to him, 'My teacher, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has made you well.' Immediately he regained his sight and followed him on the way.

ALL SAINTS' & ALL SOULS' We shall celebrate All Saints' Day on Sunday next, 3<sup>rd</sup> November, with the usual pattern of morning worship in all three churches. On Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November, there will be acts of remembrance for all who have died in conflicts here in Ireland and across the wider world in Castletownroche and Doneraile at the regular services at 10.00am. At 4.00pm in St James's, Mallow, there will be the annual service of Remembrance & Thanksgiving, to which the recently bereaved are especially welcome, where we will remember our departed loved ones and, in this bi-centennial year, we shall also remember especially past worshippers.
